**Amendment offered by Mr. McIntyre (NC)**

**Amendment Description**

The proposal would direct \$50 million dollars in mandatory spending to address the water and wastewater backlog at USDA. The water and wastewater needs of rural America are immense, and this language is a sharp reduction from the commitments we have made in years past. Most of the backlog funding we provide here today would go out as loans that are repaid to the treasury.

**[2013 Farm Bill]**

At the appropriate place in title VI, insert the following:

1 **SEC. \_\_\_\_\_. FUNDING OF PENDING RURAL DEVELOPMENT**  
2 **LOAN AND GRANT APPLICATIONS.**

3 (a) **IN GENERAL.**—The Secretary shall use funds  
4 made available under subsection (b) to provide funds for  
5 applications that are pending on the date of enactment  
6 of this Act in accordance with the terms and conditions  
7 of section 6029 of the Food, Conservation, and Energy  
8 Act of 2008 (Public Law 110–246; 122 Stat. 1955).

9 (b) **FUNDING.**—Notwithstanding any other provision  
10 of law, beginning in fiscal year 2014, of the funds of the  
11 Commodity Credit Corporation, the Secretary shall use to  
12 carry out this section \$50,000,000, to remain available  
13 until expended.
